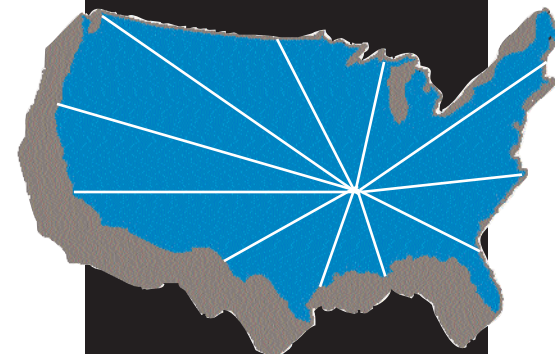
If accepted into the SLI, you or your employer will be billed for the tuition fee of \$350. Tuition must be paid to be accepted into this program.

THE VISION

The Searcy Leadership Institute is aimed at developing a network of talented leaders for present and future community needs. To meet this vision, the Leadership Institute seeks to:

- * *Identify and motivate individuals with leadership potential.*
- * *Acquaint them with community needs, challenges, and opportunities.*
- * *Offer a forum of exchange on methods for dealing with community issues.*
- * *Challenge potential leaders to become involved with local issues and the process of decision making.*

THE CURRICULUM

PARTICIPANT SELECTION

A selection committee will give careful attention to choosing a class that represents a cross-section of the community. Participants will be active in business, education, the arts, religion, government, community-based organizations, ethnic and minority groups. They will reflect the diversity of the central Arkansas community with a balanced gender, race, socio-economic and geographic representation that closely parallels the demographics of the metropolitan area.



APPLICATION

Applications for participation in the Searcy Leadership Institute may be made on behalf of someone or individuals may apply themselves. Chamber affiliation is a requirement for application to Searcy Leadership Institute. All applications for participation must be received at the Chamber office no later than August 13, 2010.



TIME COMMITMENT

The Searcy Leadership Institute consists of full day training sessions. Each session will generally be scheduled on the second Tuesday of each month from 8:15 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. Program participants are expected to attend every session. While emergencies do arise, any participant missing more than two sessions of scheduled events may be dropped from the program and no portion of the tuition will be refunded.

TUITION

The tuition fee for each participant selected is \$350.
